THE ESTATE AND THE WINE

- Château Hautes Graves d'Arthus is located at Vignonet, a village in the Saint-Emilion jurisdiction, 7 km from the magnificent mediaeval town that has been a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1999.
- The estate has belonged to the Musset family since the early 20th century. The current owner, Jean-Frédéric Musset, having succeeded his father Gérard Musset, continues to work with great respect for the terroir and to lavish the same care on the vineyard, making wines in the traditional way to ensure consistently high quality.
- Varietal mix: 88% Merlot, 12% Cabernet Franc.
- Soil and subsoil: Gravel and sand.
- Average age of the vines: Over 65 years old.
- · Harvest: By hand.
- Vinification: Traditional, in temperature-controlled concrete vats. Vatting for 4-5 weeks.
- Maturing: A rigorously selected batch for sale directly from the estate is matured for 12 months in French oak barrels.
- Owner-winegrower: EARL des Vignobles JF MUSSET.





TASTING NOTES

Aspect: A deep garnet red.

Nose: Powerful and complex, combining ripe

fruit aromas with toasted notes.

Palate: Full-bodied, with structured tannins and

a nicely rounded finish.



Serving temperature: 16 - 18° C.

Pairing suggestions: Delicious with roast or grilled meat

or with cheese.

Ageing potential: 10 to 15 years
