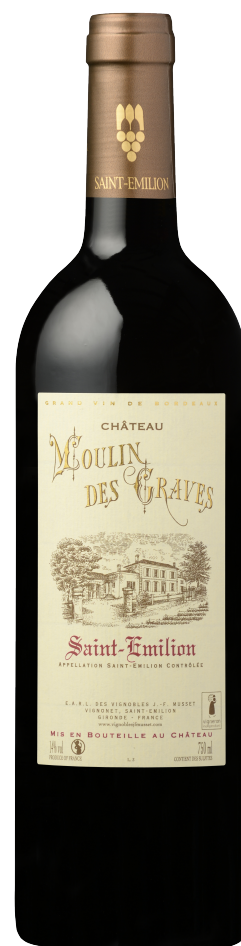

## THE ESTATE AND THE WINE

- This family estate, a former cooperage, belonged to Aurèle David, the current owner's great-great-uncle. Jean-Frédéric Musset, having succeeded his father, continues to work with great respect for the terroir and to lavish the same care on the vineyard, making wines in the traditional way to ensure consistently high quality.
- Varietal mix: 88% Merlot, 12% Cabernet Franc.
- Soil and subsoil: Gravel, silty clay, sand.
- Average age of the vines: Over 35 years old.
- Harvest: By hand.
- Vinification: Traditional, in temperature-controlled concrete vats. Vatting for 4-5 weeks.
- Maturing: A rigorously selected batch for sale directly from the estate is matured for 12 months in French oak barrels.
- Owner-winegrower: EARL des Vignobles JF MUSSET.



## TASTING NOTES

**Aspect** : Deep garnet red.

**Nose** : Ripe red fruit and spice aromas.

**Palate** : Full-bodied and well-structured, with a fresh finish.
